The Executive Board of the Friends of Boyden Library want to wish everyone a happy, healthy and prosperous 2016 and to take this opportunity to **thank all of you** for your support and encouragement to the Library and our group this past year. Through your membership contributions and your support of our two book sales we were able to sponsor a number of programs at the Boyden Library.

We are once again beginning our annual membership drive. I think it is important for you to know how much you do for the library.

Did you know your support provided the following activities in 2015?

- In the Adult Area a four-author series that included such luminaries as Hank Phillippi Ryan, Ken Gloss, and Alex Beam, as well as two music programs \$2,500
- In the Children's Area 12 programs such as Teddy Bear Picnic, Mrs. Dow's Art Cart, Barn Babies, etc. \$3,500
- In the Young Adult Area, in conjunction with a grant from the Partners in Patriotism Program, the Foxborough Reads Series consisting of 8 programs at various venues in town based on the book, **The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe** \$2,700
- Purchasing books and DVDs for all areas of the library \$2,200

We are working diligently with Manny Leite, the new Director, and the library staff to make sure that the programs we support and sponsor reach every segment of the town, as we believe the LIBRARY is the cornerstone of the community.

First off, I want to extend a 'Thank You' to everyone I've met over the past few months. I am excited to be in Foxborough and I know 2016 will be a terrific year for Boyden Library. I especially want to thank the Friends of Boyden Library for their dedication and look forward to working with them in 2016.

Our Friends Rental DVD collection is thriving! Highlighting mainstream and current releases, the rental DVDs are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. All revenue generated by DVD rentals is returned to the Friends and is used to build up a viable DVD collection. DVDs may be rented for one week for a \$2.00 fee, and renewed an additional week for another \$2.00. All rental DVDs are available in the library's regular circulation; however, NO holds may be placed on rental DVDs.

The Children's Room had a successful Fall and have plenty of story times and events for the Winter! Please check our website (www.boydenlibrary.org) for an updated list of children's programs.

Friends of Boyden Library continue to sponsor upcoming programs! Our Sunday Concert Series continues on January 17th with World Music duo of *Colby & Keila*, on February 28th musician/funnyman *Howie Newman* and on March 13th the Celtic duo of *Two Old Friends*. The Friends are also sponsoring two upcoming Spring Speaker programs: *Irish Voices* with Stephen Collins and *Golf Links* presented by Chuck Burgess.

One thing I've learned about Foxborough: the Boyden Library has become many things to many people who pass through its doors. I feel a great sense of pride in their past accomplishments and know we'll continue to provide the community with exemplary programming, electronic resources, museum passes, free Internet, and traditional library services. 2015 was another exciting year for the Friends of Boyden Library and we are proud of all we were able to accomplish.

Here's a recap of some of the great things the Friends and your donations did in 2015!

Spring and Fall Book Sales

- We raised over \$6,000 dollars in 2015 with book sales in May and November
