The Book Shop line includes the books from selling *The Violin Conspiracy* from which we only receive a small percentage. We still have to pay Unlikely Story for the books so the income looks higher than the actual will be. Memberships are doing well. Paid some program expenses.

## Director's Report/Teen Librarian/Youth Services Librarian: Jennifir Huston

- **Libby** is applying for a \$20,000 LSTA Grant for Makerspace, library wants more STEAM programs focused for all ages. Need laptops which cost about \$1,159.
- Janice made a motion to earmark \$1,500 for the purchase of 4 laptops on the condition that the library is awarded the Grant. There was a question regarding the specifications for the laptops (Windows upgradable and sufficient memory). The motion provided the Executive Board the authority to allot an additional \$500 to cover any specification driven increase in cost, second by Colleen. Motion passed.

  Library will be purchasing additional materials for the Makerspace such as a Cricut machine, Glow Forge, coding programs, sewing machine and fabric. Thinking of setting it up in the Café, but with the ability to move equipment around on a wheeled cart. Katherine brought up the need for craft books which is a good idea.
- Libby wants to thank the Friends for sponsoring Murder Mystery Program and selling books at Community Reads author event. Very successful!
- The Human Library was not well attended for various reasons but it was special seeing community members connect & socialize. Appreciated Margi & Betsy who participated as Librarians.
- Friends sponsored workshops: BollyX Dance, Mixed Media Art, Gardening & Candle making.
- Emma purchased materials to make a Fairy Light Jar craft during Graphic Novel Book Club.
- Booking performers for activities sponsored by Friends, includes Miss Mehta Earth Day Art Class, Records & Burpee Traveling Zoo Show. Block booking with Wrentham Library for a discount for a Indoor Mini Golf.
- Summer Reading Program prizes are being collected including Gift Cards for Ally's Cookies & Ice Cream Beach Club.
- Katelyn assistant librarian left to be closer to home. Two new Pages.
